Tuesday Teaching the Foundational Story to the Taliabo in Asia Pacific

Greg and Kadie Ried minister among the **Taliabo people of Asia Pacific**. Both were equipped by ethnostraining.ca. The Taliabo church leaders have begun teaching Creation-to-Christ Bible lessons in the village where the Reids minister, and over 100 people have been attending the twice-weekly lessons. It has been over 10 years since this village church last went through this chronological study, and many of the younger people have never heard the lessons before.

"Pray for the Taliabo teachers ... [and] for the salvation of many. The gospel has been here for three decades now. In some ways, the challenges the church faces here are similar to those in North America. There are many 'cultural Christians' that have no understanding of the gospel. Pray that many hearts are opened."

Wednesday **A Successful Translation Check for the Higaunon People** of the Philippines

We prayed that God would grant the team good health and endurance during the translation check of the books of Ecclesiastes and Jeremiah. The team was able to check the book of Ecclesiastes in four days. Then, after 18 days of intense work, the translation team finished checking the book of Jeremiah. Praise the Lord for progress made in the Higaunon translation.

The team has now completed much of the Old Testament. "As always we ask you to pray that our health will continue to be good so that we can continue on with the rest of the translation of the Old Testament."

Thursday Looking to the Lord for Direction in Asia Pacific

Christoph and Susanna Henrich serve with Ethnos360 Germany in Asia Pacific and are currently working on culture and language acquisition. In March, Christoph and a team attended a conference among the Wana people. They were blessed to hear the Wana read Joshua 5 for the first time in their heart language, and they were encouraged by the Wana believers' passion for sharing the gospel with other villages. Praise the Lord for this encouraging time of fellowship.

Friday Church Planters Needed

Ray and Jessica Willet serve in Papua New Guinea (PNG).
