The downstairs would function as a meeting place for church services, Bible classes and discipleship classes for the men who are desiring to travel to their neighbours bringing the Good News. The upstairs would function as an apartment for Luis and Ana.

# Wednesday Pray for Helpers for Literacy Program in Guinea, West Africa

Ruth serves in Guinea. Pray for her as she prepares for a literacy workshop. "It's still half a year away, but there is a lot to do, and it needs to be all done to send in a few months ahead of time ... The biggest challenge right now is to have someone to work with. ... Since people have started their work in the fields, everyone is very busy. But I'm thankful that we got some spelling rules figured out and were able to write quite a few stories already. You can pray with me that I can find some people to check if the stories are easy to read."



#### Thursday Pray for Manubu' Young People in the Philippines

Gene and Carol Trudeau minister among the Agusan Manubu' people of the Philippines. "[Earlier this summer,] over 200 Manubu' young people who are believers from a number of Manubu' churches gathered at the Manubu' village we lived in for many years. They were taught the four Daniel lessons we wrote about how Daniel and his three friends stayed faithful to the Lord no matter what pressure was put on them to conform to ungodliness. The young people were also taught other Scripture to encourage them to stand firm for the Lord. And



they discussed those issues. ... Please pray that they will indeed continue to love and serve the Lord."

# Friday Pray for the Konomala Church in Papua New Guinea

Seth and Kaitlyn Sanford minister among the Konomala people of Papua New Guinea. As the Konomala church enters "a new chapter," the Sanfords and co-workers Luke and Ellenie Hodgdon desire to help believers walk in faithfulness.
