Albert and Lynne Castelijn minister among the Banwaon people of the Philippines. In March 2025, the Banwaon church will have a dedication for the Banwaon New Testament. Albert is working with Bob Clark to complete the final steps before the dedication. Some of these steps include typesetting, writing introductions for each book and final proofreading. Pray for the Castelijns and Bob as they work long, intense days to prepare the New Testaments for printing. Please pray for us as we make preparations for this. ... We are targeting March as the start date for the Bible teaching, and we're not yet sure when to do the literacy program. ... Please pray for wisdom and strength to do what needs to be done in here for God's name to exalted among the Elsengg!"



Wednesday Training and an Answer to Prayer

Wes Goddard serves in Paraguay and Brazil ministering to the Pai and Ava Guaraní people. In October, we prayed for Wes's Pai co-teacher Edgar and Edgar's wife. They were wanting to build a room onto their house to be used as a shop for printing Bible lesson books. Praise God that the funds were covered by donors, and some building materials were taken to the site. Continue to pray as Wes and his Pai co-workers teach and train members of the Ava Guaraní church. Wes was encouraged recently after a group he was teaching began to "catch the vision that God wants to use them to teach!"

Thursday Praise God for New Simba Brothers and Sisters in Bolivia

Jack and Suzie Russell minister among the Simba people of Bolivia. "The work continues daily, and once a year each of the three church plants hold a three-day Bible camp they call a 'conference.'" In October, a conference was held in one Simba community, and "there were 24 [people] who made professions of faith and were baptized." In November, there was a second conference in a different community "where the Simba church is a little more established, [and] there were six new professions of faith and five baptized." Praise God for new Simba brothers and sisters. Pray for a third conference that will take place December 29 through January 1 among a large Simba community with a growing group of believers.

Friday Trusting the Lord's Timing in Mexico

Pray for Katie Moore and her co-workers who minister in Las Moras, Mexico. Because of unrest in the region, the team has left Las Moras for the time being and is working remotely. "Please pray that God would bring peace to regions with unrest all over Mexico. Pray for the safety of people who live in these areas and for the spread of the gospel. Please pray that our team would be able to return soon to Las Moras and to trust the Lord's timing as we wait." Pray for wisdom as the security team meets with the Las Moras team again at the end of January.
