Harold and Christine Hull serve in Papua New Guinea (PNG). They are looking for two families to form a church planting team with them so they can begin living and ministering among a people group in PNG. "Pray for us as we start talking with the other families on the field. [Pray] that God would show us all who He wants us to partner with and where He would want us to go." Pray for more labourers. "There are many people groups asking for missionaries, but the labourers are few and getting fewer and fewer."



Tuesday Pray for the hearts and minds of the Kuyu

Jonathan and Devon Ames minister among the Kuyu people of Papua New Guinea. Pray for Jonathan and Devon, Jacob and Katie DeValve, and Michael and Morgan LeBlanc as they progress through culture and language acquisition (CLA). "Pray for our next CLA evaluations [in February]; it would be great if one of us gets to 'capable mid,' as this opens the door for literacy. ... Pray for the hearts and minds of the Kuyu, for genuine, healthy relationships in the local and larger Kuyu community. Pray for continued excitement and positive momentum in the community as we move toward literacy and finish up CLA."



Wednesday News From the Tanguat Church, Papua New Guinea

Canadians Derek and Chantal Chen minister among the Tanguat people of Papua New Guinea. "Please pray for the church. They're wrestling with the spiritual truth that putting their trust in money — and along with that, any other worldly thing — is the same as putting trust in oneself." The Chens still feel like outsiders and get overwhelmed trying to share the Truth in an understandable and relevant way. Pray for wisdom. Pray that they would "let the Holy Spirit do His work through His Word." Pray for guidance as they prepare for an outreach to two villages this spring.

Kevin and Wendy Case minister among the Tepehuan people of Mexico. A group of Tepehuan people heard a clear presentation of the gospel at a Christmas party. "One man commented afterward that it was as clear as the rooster crows in the morning." As the Cases followed up with two families, they found that one family was still clinging to traditions of a false religion while the other family's response was "a bit more encouraging. ... Pray that the two groups will consider the truths they heard ... and not just add these truths to their present beliefs but experience the life-changing power of the gospel in their lives. ... Be praying for wisdom as we move forward with the teaching in the two communities."
