"The three Dom churches have gone over many bumps in the road [in 2024], but they are still meeting every week. Gena (church leader and my primary translation helper) continues to evangelize in the many clans of the tribe. [Church leaders] Martin and Bapka are also doing outreach."

## Thursday **Pray for the Indigenous Youth in Paraguay and Brazil**

**Wes Goddard** serves in **Paraguay and Brazil** ministering to the **Paĩ and Ava Guaraní** people. In December, there was a camp for Paĩ youth. “Around 97 youth attended from a few different Paĩ communities. I praise the Lord for the provision of funds. ... My Paraguayan pastor friend did a great job with the Bible teaching during the camp and clearly presented the gospel message. ... The youth are already talking about another planned youth camp around the end of January at another community.” Pray that God would continually bring to mind what they learned at the camp and that He would work in their hearts so that they might believe.

## Friday **Pray for Wayumi in 2025**

**Wayumi** is a program in Jersey Shore, **Pennsylvania**, that allows attendees to experience realities of cross-cultural missions without leaving North America. Pray for the team serving at Wayumi as they prepare for upcoming programs this spring and summer. Pray for Wayumi teachers as they prepare material; pray that it will be informative, impactful and motivating. Pray that many people would attend Wayumi this year and that they would leave encouraged to serve the Lord in whatever way He has planned for them.
