#### Monday Pray for the Mibu people of Papua New Guinea

In celebration of serving in Papua New Guinea (PNG) for 75 years, we are praying for a series of people groups New Tribes Mission PNG is working among. The Mibu people live high in the Finisterre mountains. They are a small people group of only about 450 in population spread out over five different villages. Traditionally the Mibu people have held a mixture of beliefs. After missionaries taught God's Word in the Mibu language, the Mibu people's entire worldview changed. People accepted Christ's death on the cross as payment for their sins, a church was born and discipled, and the church began to teach God's Word to their neighbours. The church has now grown to encompass all five villages of the Mibu language group and has spread to seven more villages, impacting three other language groups. Please pray with the Mibu people.

# Tuesday Pray for those translating the Bible for the Nivaclé people, Paraguay

Colton and Tanja Twigg serve in Paraguay. "Tanja has been working hard in the print shop. Our coworkers who work with the Nivaclé people just finished revising the book of Romans, and so Tanja has been printing the books and putting them together. They ordered 1,000 copies, and so far, she is at the halfway point. It is such an awesome opportunity to be a part of getting God's Word into the hands of the [Nivaclé] people. Please continue to pray for Tanja as she still has a lot of work ahead of her and for our co-workers as they press on in the Nivaclé Bible revision."

### Wednesday Pray for the Iski Church as they Spread the Good News

Jason and Nisae Williamson minister among the Iski people of Papua New Guinea. The Iski church currently has three outreaches to other Iski communities. At one outreach location, "the amount of interest [in God's Word] is unprecedented, [and] ... it's evident that many of them have placed their faith in the work of Jesus Christ." Praise God for new brothers and sisters in Christ. Bible teachers are also teaching families in two other outreach locations. "Pray for the faithfulness of the leaders, for them to continue to live uprightly and rely on God for daily strength. Pray also for those coming to the teachings, that they wouldn't be pulled away by other things but that they would commit to coming and hearing the truth of God revealed."

## Thursday "Church growth is spilling out into other language groups!"

Canadians Tim and Robin Walker minister to the P1 people of Latin America. One P1 man, Alexander, and his family, along with two national missionary ladies, are working with another people group of Latin America. The people had missionaries at one time who brought Bible teaching and made "a good start on the New Testament translation," and a church was born. However, the missionaries had to leave 20 years ago. Now Alexander and his teammates are taking on the task. "The P1 church growth is spilling out into other language groups! This amazes me. A prayer for Alex and Elendie [a P1 musician who is teaching the people how to play guitar and sing] ... is much appreciated."

# Friday Isolated Communities are Asking for Missionaries in Papua New Guinea

Mark and Shelbi Fitzpatrick serve in Papua New Guinea. "This month, we surveyed the Gende people. ... While some showed little interest in having us, one village welcomed us warmly. They expressed a deep desire to understand God's Word. ... They recognized that without it being in their language, they could not grasp its meaning. They earnestly asked for missionaries to come, not only to translate but also to teach them so they could truly know what God's Word says." Praise God for this hunger for Truth. Pray for the Fitzpatricks and their teammates, Ricky and Kati Sanford and Nate and Laura Clonch, as they prepare to move into Gende land. Pray that God would prepare the Gende people's hearts.
